Inter-Firms 2026 Regulations

Grading

- No Team may play Below the Grade of its Highest Graded Player.
- A Player who has no Grade and enters becomes that Grade which they have entered for the entirety of the Tournament.
- Any player not graded in the Munster Directory will be graded at the discretion of St. Anne's Tennis Club Inter-Firms Tournament Committee.
- The Tennis Munster grading list at the time the entry closes will be used as the
 official grading list for the tournament.
- The minimum age for participants is 18 years of age at the closure of entries.
- If 2 or more players from a cup winning team in 2025 enter together in 2026, they must enter in the next highest grade.
- If you are a past or current member of a tennis club, then you are not permitted to enter the beginner's section.

Subbing

- Substitutes must be approved 24 hours in advance by the Tournament Referee (contact office). Substitutes cannot show up and expect to play without first being approved by the Tournament Referee.
- Once a player is named on a Team, that player may <u>NOT</u> sub within the same Category or Lower for the entirety of the Tournament. Players named on a Team can sub up in a higher Category.
- A Substitute must be a Correctly Graded Player and can only sub for players of the same grade or lower, i.e. A Grade 5 player can get a Grade 5 or Grade 6 to sub.
- If a sub of a grade higher than the true grade of the team entered plays in a game, the score of the pair involving the illegal player will be declared null and void. This decision will be made retrospectively by the tournaments committee.
- A Substitute may <u>NOT</u> sub for multiple teams in the same Round Robin group.
- A Substitute may <u>NOT</u> sub for both the Cup and Plate draws in the second week,
 e.g. if a Substitute subs for a team in the Plate, they can <u>NOT</u> sub in the Cup.
- If a person is playing in the tournament (named on a team) and subbing up a Category, they are only allowed to sub twice If they are knocked out of their own grade, they can then continue to sub with the higher Category.
- If a player has subbed in the plate in a category, they are not permitted to sub for another team plate or cup in the same category and vice versa.
- All subs are only allowed to sub twice, if they sub a 3rd time on the same team, they will now remain part of that team.
- The above Notes apply to subbing in Category Premier, A, B, C and D only.
- A list of available subs can be found on the club noticeboard.

Format

- Each Team will consist of two Men and two Ladies.
- The first week format is Men's doubles and Ladies doubles.

- The second week format is Mixed Doubles. The pairings of Mixed Team A & Mixed Team B are predetermined when filling out the entry form.
- The finals day format for Cup events will consist of Men's, Ladies and Mixed doubles.
- The finals day format for Plate events will consist of Mixed doubles only.
- BABOLAT Team tennis balls will be used.

Scoring

- The Winner of each Match will be the Team with the Highest Combined Total.
- In the event of a Draw, the Match will be decided on the result of the Mixed Pair A Team.
- First to Reach 9 Games, NO Tie Break at 8 All.

In the round robin competitions: -

If teams are tied with the same number of overall games won, they will be separated by score difference.

If a team does not complete its schedule all its games are scratched.

If groups have, or end up with, different numbers of team's places other than 1^{st} are decided by average points per game.

Late Arrivals/Walk Over

- Teams Must check in 15 minutes Before Scheduled Match Time.
- If a Team (or part of a Team) is Late, the Opposing Team (or part of a Team) Will receive a Walk Over.

Availability

- All Teams must be available to play when scheduled.
- Play will commence on Monday 4th May 2026.
- Extent of availability will determine whether an Entry is Accepted or Rejected.

Team Captain

The Team Captain is responsible for all matters relating to the Team.

- Availability of Team Members.
- Check Scheduled Time for Matches (available on Tennis Ireland Tournament Software)
- That all attire and footwear is approved for tennis. If in doubt, please check with the tournament committee.
- That team members are physically fit and able to play without undue risk of injury.
- Check in Team 15 minutes before Scheduled Match Time.
- Check if Substitutions are acceptable.
- Indicate Clearly which are Mixed A & Mixed B pairings on their Team.
- Return Match Score & Tennis Balls to Tournament Office.

General

• In the event of a dispute, a resolution of which will rest with the Tournament Committee and their decision will be final and irrevocable.
